High Representative meets Italian Foreign Minister Di Maio

European integration, strengthening of the rule of law and economic development should be at the forefront of BiH's efforts. The international community stands ready to help, to achieve European standards", said the High Representative.

The High Representative expressed his appreciation to Foreign Minister Di Maio for Italy's continued support to Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Office of the High Representative and the International Community's efforts to help Bosnia and Herzegovina advance reforms.
