Authorities must protect journalists



"Authorities in Bosnia and Herzegovina must protect journalists and ensure that they can perform their professional duties without being intimidated or threatened. Threats against media professionals represent an attack on human rights.

"Journalists play a vital role in every democratic society and law enforcement authorities must ensure their safety, and demonstrate that there can be no impunity for attacks against them," the High Representative stated.
