## LAW ON AMENDMENTS TO THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

#### Article 1

In the Criminal Procedure Code of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina, 36/03), in Article 20, item g) shall be amended to read as follows:

«g) «An authorised official person» is a person having an appropriate authorisation within the police authorities in Bosnia and Herzegovina, including the State Investigation and Protection Agency, the State Border Service, the Judicial Police, the Financial Police, as well as within the customs authorities, tax authorities and military police authorities in Bosnia and Herzegovina».

### Article 2

This Law shall enter into force on the eighth day of the publication in the Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
