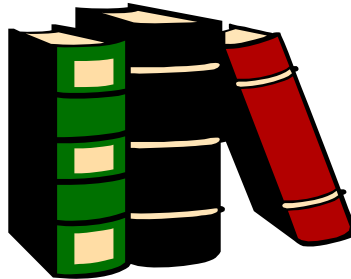

LAW AMENDING THE LAW ON THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

“Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”, 42/03

[NOTE: The Law on Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina was imposed by the High Representative Decision, No. 79/02 \(“Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”, 38/02. Afterwards, the Law was adopted by the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina and published in the “Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”, 30/03.](#)

LAW AMENDING THE LAW ON THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Article 1

In the Law on the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina (“Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”, No. 38/02), in Article 5, Paragraph 1, in the last line, in the end and after the words “Minister of Security”, instead of the full stop shall be added the comma and the new line to read as follows:

“ – Minister of Defense”

Article 2

In Article 7, Paragraph 1, in the end, after the words: “Deputy Minister” shall be added a comma and the words: “except for the Minister of Defense, who shall have two Deputy Ministers”.

Article 3

After Article 46 shall be added a new Article 46a to read as follows:

Article 46a

“Within one year following the entry into force of this Law, a separate law shall be passed regulating the organization of Council of Ministers, by ensuring equal representation of the constituent peoples of Bosnia and Herzegovina, as provided under Article V.4.(b) and Article IX.3. of the Bosnia and Herzegovina Constitution”.

Article 4

This Law shall enter into force on the eighth day of its publication in the “Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”, and shall be also published in the official gazettes of Entities and the Brcko District of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
