LAW AMENDING THE LAW ON MINISTRIES AND OTHER BODIES OF ADMINISTRATION OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

“Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”, 26/04

NOTE: The Law on Ministries and Other Bodies of Administration of Bosnia and Herzegovina was published in the “Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”, 5/03.

Pursuant to Article IV.4 of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at the session of the House of Representatives, held on 23 April 2004, and the session of the House of Peoples, held on 26 April 2004, enacted the following

LAW AMENDING THE LAW ON MINISTRIES AND OTHER BODIES OF ADMINISTRATION OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Article 1

In the Law on Ministries and Other Bodies of Administration of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina, No. 5/03 and No. 42/03), in Article 12, paragraph 1, sub-paragraph 10 shall be amended to read as follows:

“- taking care of the refugee rights and issues in BiH after their status is identified;”

Article 2

In Article 12, paragraph 1, sub-paragraph 17 shall be deleted.

Article 3

In Article 14, paragraph 1, sub-paragraph 8 shall be amended to read as follows: *“Creating, taking care of and implementing BiH immigration and asylum policy.”*

Article 4

In Article 14, paragraph 1, the new sub-paragraph 9 shall be added to read as follows: *“Regulating procedures and method of organizing the service concerning movement and stay of aliens in BiH”*

Article 5

This Law shall enter into force on the eighth day after its publication in the Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina and shall also be published in the official gazettes of both entities and Brcko District of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
