LAW ON CHANGES AND AMENDMENTS TO THE LAW ON CIVIL SERVICE IN THE INSTITUTIONS OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

NOTE: The High Representative's Decision Imposing the Law on Civil Service in the Institutions of Bosnia and Herzegovina was published in the “Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”, 12/02.

Based on Article IV.4.a) of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at the session of the House of Representatives held on 20 November 2003 and at the session of the House of Peoples held on 28 January 2004, adopted the

LAW ON CHANGES AND AMENDMENTS TO THE LAW ON CIVIL SERVICE IN THE INSTITUTIONS OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Article 1.

In the Law on Civil Service in the Institutions of Bosnia and Herzegovina (“Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”, No. 12/02 and 19/02) – hereinafter: The Law, in Article 4 behind the word: “hereinafter: the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina” shall be added words: “the Ombudsman of Bosnia and Herzegovina”.

Article 2.

In Article 6 of the Law, behind the Item 3 shall be added a new Item 4 which reads as follow: “This Law shall not apply to those employed with the Office of the Human Rights Ombudsmen of Bosnia and Herzegovina”.

Article 3.

This Law shall enter into force on the eight day of its publishing in the “Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”.
