ON AMENDMENTS TO THE LAW ON COURTS IN THE
FEDERATION OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Article 1

In the Law on Courts in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (“Official Gazette of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina”, nos. 38/05 and 22/06), in Article 22 the following changes and amendments shall be made:

Paragraph 3, in item 4), the word „Lukavac“ shall be deleted, and in item 5) the word “Banovići“ shall be deleted, and in the same Paragraph, new items 6) and 7) shall be added to read as follows:

- “6) The Municipal Court in Lukavac for the territory of the municipality Lukavac;
- 7) The Municipal Court in Banovici for the territory of the municipality Banovici;”

In Paragraph 6, in item 2) the word „Jajce“ and the sentence „The Municipal Court in Bugojno shall have a branch in Jajce that covers the territory of the municipalities of Jajce and Dobretici;” shall be deleted.

In the same Paragraph shall be added item 4) to read as follows:

“The Municipal Court in Jajce for the territory of the municipalities Jajce and Dobretici”.

In Article 7, in item 1), after the word “Mostar”, the full stop was inserted and the following words shall be deleted: “, and for the territory of the Municipality of Čitluk“.

In the same Paragraph, a new item 4) shall be added to read as follows:

“The Municipal Court in Citluk for the territory of the municipality Citluk”.

Article 2

Newly established Municipal Courts shall commence the operation when High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina decide that necessary conditions for the operation of courts are met.

Article 3

This Law shall enter into force on the following day of its publication, and shall start apply on the first day of mandate of judges appointed by the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council into new established courts.
