Dear Minister Novic,

I refer to your 9 August request for a waiver of the High Representative's Decision of 27 April 2000 prohibiting the reallocation of socially owned land.

I regret to inform you that the information provided in your letter of 9 August 2000 is not sufficient to approve the land allocation in question. As you are aware, the impetus for the 27 April 2000 Decision was to ensure that reallocations of socially owned land do not unduly impede the return of displaced persons and refugees to their pre-conflict homes. It is not our intent to prohibit land reallocations that are non-discriminatory and in the best interests of the community.

With respect to the mentioned, please find here attached the guidelines intended to assist you in the process of requesting a waiver. Once the Ministry provides this office with information concerning, *inter alia*, the prior use of the land, the request for a waiver of the High Representative's aforesaid Decision will be fully considered.
