- There is still uncertainty as to who is the new US president; new vote count must be carried out in State of Florida
- Dr Filip Turcinovic, Banja Luka University professor of International law and Foreign Affairs, says course of US foreign policy will not change, regardless who is new US president
- BiH Presidency Chairman Zivko Radisic says he was preparing congratulatory note to Bush but stopped after hearing latest news on re-count (00:30)
- "I do not expect big changes from new US administration in its position on BiH" – BiH Foreign Minister Jadranko Prlic (00:28)
- RS Government earmarks KM 12 million to pay pensions
- Pensioners continue their protests throughout RS demanding payment of at least two of six overdue pensions; pensioners demand payments by 9 November
- RS healthcare workers put moratorium on their strike in period from 9 to 14 November due to November elections – RS Healthcare Syndicate
- RS Independent Syndicate of Railway Engineers ends strike; they receive back salaries but demand to replace top rail management not fulfilled
- RS Prime Minister Milorad Dodik inaugurates customs terminal at Gradiska border crossing into service (00:55)
- RS Commission for Missing Persons exhumes eight more bodies of Serb civilians at Lav cemetery in Sarajevo – Commission member Slobodan Avlijas
- Monuments and memorials dedicated to fallen Serb soldiers and civilians desecrated in Prijedor, Milici and Gorazde
- Council of Europe convenes session in Strasbourg and, among other, will discuss current situation in Yugoslavia
- Valjevo Correctional Institutions inmates start riot on Wednesday
- SPS Serbia General Secretary Zoran Andjelkovic denies claims that Milosevic will not run in SPS presidential race at party's special election convention on 25 November
- 10 persons found dead under landslide that fell on Podgorica-Kolasin route in Montenegro
- If Tudjman were alive now, he would be indicted for war crimes – ICTY Deputy Prosecutor Graham Blewitt (00:23)
