News Headlines

- Izetbegovic does not support Gligoric's nomination for chairman of the BiH Council of Ministers because he believes that the IC does not support Gligoric
- Gligoric says he will attend the BiH House of Representatives session on 17 May and that Radisic did not change his mind in regard to nominating him
- BiH Presidency and BiH House of Representatives are responsible for the election of a new chairman for the BiH Council of Ministers – OHR spokesperson James Ferguson
- After meeting with UK Ambassador to BiH Graham Hand, Petar Djokic says that Gligoric is still serious candidate for the chairman's post of the BiH Council of Minister
- SNS expects that Radisic will not follow steps of Poplasen in nominating chairman-elect of the BiH Council of Ministers
- SNSD says that the Chairman of the BiH Council of Minister must have good relations with the RS Government
- Petar Djokic schedules 11th session of RS Assembly for 29 May, adding that the first agenda item is RS Government report
