Poplasen adviser Mirjana Sainovic rejects Dodik allegations

Adviser to former RS President Nikola Poplasen, Mirjana Sainovic resolutely denied allegations Milorad Dodik made on Tuesday during a talkshow on RTRS. According to Sainovic, Dodik said that Poplasen had requested the mobilization of RS citizens and ordered attacks on <u>SFOR</u> at the time of <u>NATO</u>'s air campaign against Yugoslavia. Sainovic confirmed that the RS Supreme Defense Council never discussed, at anytime, the mobilization or armed resistance of the RS people against the <u>NATO</u>-led <u>SFOR</u>.
