TV BiH News Headlines:

- High Representative to BiH Wolfgang Petritsch proclaims set of laws to strengthen BiH institutions (02:03)
- Barry, guest of Circle 99 Independent Intellectuals, comments on Croat referendum saying HDZ had been planning it for three years
- Petritsch says elections went smoothly and were without incident; Barry says final results to be disclosed after 17 November adding that political parties should focus on implementation of election results – joint OHR-OSCE press conference (01:22)
- Croat referendum case referred to EASC – OSCE
- “When and if OSCE decides to sanction our party, HDZ Presidency will take a stand on the matter” – HDZ spokesperson Tomic at press conference; he continued that HDZ candidates were much more successful in these than in previous elections (00:58)
- HDZ wins majorities in 5 cantonal assemblies – HDZ
- Unofficial results show Sarovic with 290,439 votes – SDS press conference
- SNSD reports Dodik wins 37,2 % while SDS candidate Sarovic takes 47,1% of votes for RS president
- Election observers give a high marks for organisation of elections, adding that media acted professionally during elections
