News Headlines

- Six people who were in critical condition from Saturday's Kakanj bus accident are now stable
- Macedonian President Boris Trajkovski and Slovene Ambassador to BiH Drago Mirošić express condolences to Izetbegović and families of Kakanj bus accident victims
- Tihomir Gligorić's nomination for Chairman of BiH Council of Ministers withdrawn because IC is unwilling to work with him
- Foreign governments demand reform of pension and energy systems in BiH before they offer financial assistance
- Rumor has it that Jadranko Prlić will be the next candidate (for two posts) for chairman of the BiH Council of Ministers and BiH Minister for European Integration
- Mladen Ivanic to be re-considered for Chairmanship of BiH Council of Ministers, but this time without preconditions – BiH Parliament delegate Branko Đokić
- Wolfgang Petritsch meets with German Foreign Minister Joschka Fischer and other German diplomats
- During Tokyo Conference on Southeast Europe, Carl Bildt said that the Balkan region is facing the possible threat of future conflicts, which would stop if Milošević left power
- Europe shocked to find out that 100 of millions of DM have disappeared due to inadequate management of financial assistance – Financial Times
- US Congress and White House dispute future US engagement in KFOR

- OSCE concerned over attack on Posavina Canton Governor Krsto Vuković, who was attacked by former Head of HDZ Orasje Board Marko Benković on 11 May; the OHR has identified Benković as an obstructor of Dayton Agreement implementation
- Swedish Merhamet humanitarian organization initiates action to collect roofing-tiles
- SNS dissatisfied with activities on establishing the BiH Council of Ministers and blames Radisić for this turn of events, and adds that it is will leaving coalition option with SDS open
