The Ambassadors confirm that the sustainable resolution of the State Property issue is to be provided legally binding intergovernmental agreement signed by the Chairman of the Council of Ministers and both Entities' Prime Ministers in line with the communiqué of the Peace Implementation Council of 30 June 2009.
