International Community Expresses Support for Democracy and Rule of Law With NGOs and Independent Media in the RS

Officials of the OHR and OSCE, as well as representatives of the US, German, French, and UK embassies in BiH today met with leaders of independent media and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) based in the Republika Srpska. International Community representatives underscored that an independent, vibrant civil society and media are cornerstones of a healthy democracy. They also expressed their concern over recent allegations of attempts to infringe upon the press freedom and rule of law in BiH and stressed the important "watch dog" role an independent press and civil society performs.
