

High Representative Appoints International Judge Prosecutors to Court of BiH

The High Representative, Christian Schwarz-Schilling, has appointed Marie Tuma as International Judge in Section I for War Crimes of the Criminal and Appellate Divisions and in Section II for Organised Crime, Economic Crime and Corruption of the Criminal and Appellate Divisions of the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The initial term of this appointment is for two years from the date of taking up of official duties, which will occur not later than 10 June 2006 subject to reappointment pursuant to the Law.
