PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF POSITION

- Well groomed with great sense of discretion and susceptibility to work in diplomatic environment;

- Knowledge of vehicle communications equipment essential;
- Good knowledge of routes all over the country;
- Valid and clean driving license (min. 5 years) essential;
- Experience in driving 4x4 vehicles essential;
- Basic First Aid knowledge;
