Bulldozer Committee gave a task to local authorities

Ashdown: Authorities Get 40 Days to Remove 50 Roadblocks

In order to accomplish the most important objective set by the international community, it is necessary to adopt 50 changes in 40 days, and the time has already started leaking, Ashdown claims

[P.2] SARAJEVO – OHR gave a 40-day deadline to BiH authorities to remove 50 roadblocks for direct foreign investments and creation of jobs. Representatives of the international community and local businessmen, gathered at the Bulldozer Committee identified 50 such roadblocks within the past 110 days. The HR, Paddy Ashdown yesterday gave the list of 50 economic reforms that should be implemented in the following period to Adnan Terzic, Chairman of the Council of Ministers. "In order to accomplish the most important objective set by the international community, it is necessary to adopt 50 changes in 40 days, and the time has already started leaking," Ashdown said yesterday, looking at his hand watch. As he said, many problems are caused by laws, which are generally good, but certain provisions are counterproductive and should be changed. Bulldozer Committee did an excellent job by identifying roadblocks, and now it is up to the Council of Ministers and entity governments to remove these roadblocks," Terzic said. When asked how realistic is to remove 50 roadblocks for a bit longer than one month, the Chairman of the Council of Ministers says it is realistic to try.

"I think that the Council of Ministers and entity governments will fulfill their obligations in time, and work of parliaments shall depend on dynamics of their session," Terzic emphasized. As one of the obstacles for a more successful business, Tomislav Grizeli, Chairman of the BiH Association of employers mentioned some provisions of the Law on defense in FBiH. "When an employer wants to build or expand a warehouse, he needs to pay atomic shelter fee to municipal authorities. This provision was taken over from the former state and it is unnecessary. This is why it should be abolished," Grizelj said. One of the roadblocks for direct foreign investments, according to Edin Muftic, general manager of the Raiffeisen Bank is the fact that when evaluating the market and business possibilities, foreign investors

"Here one gets the impression that there are totally different markets," Muftic concluded.


