Interest in Bulldozer Project Abroad As Well

After completion of the first phase of the project "50 reforms in 150 days", the Bulldozer Committee will initiate the second phase, with emphasis on local participation in the process

[P.7] SARAJEVO – Summarizing results of the first phase of the Bulldozer project, OHR says that apart from positive reactions in BiH they also received numerous reactions from abroad. The Economic attaché of the Embassy of Serbia and Montenegro expressed his interest in procedures related to the Bulldozer project and wishes to take the Committee experiences to his country. A business school from Bled, Slovenia requested presentation of the project, in order to teach their students. They expressed interest in Croatia as well, where an article on the Bulldozer Committee work was published in a weekly business magazine. EU also expressed their interest, emphasizing that implementation of Bulldozer recommendations leads BiH to Europe.

After completion of the first phase of the project "50 reforms in 150 days", the Bulldozer Committee, consisted of representatives of business associations, regional development agencies, NGOs, trade unions and government officials on various levels will initiate the second phase with the emphasis on local participation in this process. This will be done based on experience and success that was accomplished during implementation of the first phase of this initiative, Fena reported.
