Hays, Hadzipasic, Mikerevic and Damjanac on Current Status of Bulldozer Process

Attract Investments and Create Jobs

[P.07] SARAJEVO – Principal Deputy High Representative, Donald Hays, FBiH Prime Minister, Ahmet Hadzipasic, RS Prime Minister, Dragan Mikerevic and Brcko District Mayor Branko Damjanac met yesterday in Jajce in order to discuss current status of the Bulldozer process. Ambassador Hays emphasized that Bulldozer created a mechanism for BiH entrepreneurs and politicians to find “their solutions for their problems.” Prime minister Hadzipasic pointed out a significant overlap between the Bulldozer initiative and the emerging economic regions. According to him, this is due to the fact that Bulldozer and regions are genuinely business-based and that they try to improve business environment, in order to attract investments and create new jobs. Prime Minister Mikerevic underlined cooperation and partnership that has been established between the RS, FBiH, BiH and Brcko District ERUs. Brcko District mayor, Branko Damjanac emphasized that the Brcko Assembly adopted all amendments proposed by the Bulldozer Committee, which was voted as a part of the efforts of the District in creation of a positive business environment.
