## LAW ON AMENDMENTS TO THE LAW ON COURT OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

**NOTE:** The High Representative's Decision Enacting the Law on Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina was published in the "Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina", 29/00.

Pursuant to Article IV.4.a) of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at the session of the House of Representatives, held on 18 June, 2004 and at the session of the House of Peoples, held on 29 June, 2004, adopted

## LAW ON AMENDMENTS TO THE LAW ON THE COURT OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

#### Article 1

In the Law on the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Official Gazette of BiH, 29/00, 16/02, 24/02, 42/03 and 9/04), in Article 65, Paragraph 4, the full-stop shall be deleted and shall be replaced by a comma, and the following words shall be added: "and as chosen by the party who determines into which of the official languages of Bosnia and Herzegovina the translation or interpretation from the English language will be done."

### Article 2

The Constitutional-Legal Committees of both Houses of the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina shall be authorised to prepare a consolidated text of the Law on the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina within six months.

### Article 3

This Law shall enter into force on the eighth day from its publishing in the Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
