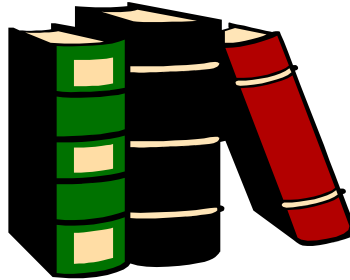

Pursuant to Article IV.3.b) of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the House of Representatives of the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at 18th session held on 7 October 2015, has adopted

AMENDMENTS

TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Article 1

In the Rules of Procedure of the House of Representatives of the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina (“Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina” No. 79/14), Article 14 shall be amended to read as follows:

“Article 14
(Immunity)

- (1) Under the Constitution of BiH and the law, the Representative shall not be held criminally or civilly liable for any acts carried out within the scope of their duties in the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
- (2) Decision whether the procedure was carried out within the scope of their duties in the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina shall be made the competent court in accordance with the Law on Immunity of BiH.”

Article 2

In Article 44 (The Constitutional and Legal Committee), in paragraph (1), line j) shall be deleted.

Article 3

- (1) In Chapter V of the Rules of Procedure of the House of Representatives of the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Section O, Authentic interpretation of a law and other act, and articles from 146 to 149, shall be deleted.
- (2) Current articles from 150 to 208 shall become articles 146 to 204.

Article 4 (Entry into force)

These Amendments to the Rules of Procedure shall enter into force on the eighth day after publication in the “Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina”.
