IJC Strategy

In July 2001, the IJC finalised its strategy for the period 2001 – 2002. Its <u>Strategy Paper</u> sets out its major goals and priorities for judicial reform and the specific activities proposed to achieve them within that period. 15 Projects were identified out of which 5 core priorities are reproduced below:

- 1. Completion of the Comprehensive Review Process. (This process is time-limited by law and the relevant periods expire early in 2002.)
- Completion of reform of the appointment process for judges and prosecutors
- 3. Reform of court administration and management
- 4. New legislation on enforcement of civil judgements
- 5. New legislation on civil procedure
