## Sarajevo

On the last session of the District Brcko Transit Assembly a lot has been said about creating the better conditions for return. Recent protests of the citizens were the main reason for this session. Slobodanka Radojkovic reported.

## **Sarajevo**

The last decision of the Federal Government is to give KM 15 millions for solving the problems of people that are living under tents across the country. There is still a question on double users of the property which slows down the implementation of Law on property. Adis Saranovic produced the report.

Ten houses whose owners are Serbs from Sarajevo suburb Nedjarici were ruined during the recent demining and cleaning of the ground. The houses were already devastated. But its owners will ask for compensation. Damir Kaletovic produced the report.

One of the best profitable jobs in B&H is stealing of the cars. In the last few months in Sarajevo Canton 240 cars were stolen. Perpetrators are usually well trained and equipped. Canton Sarajevo Police with co-operation of RS Police and the citizens found and returned 65 cars to their owners. Svjetlana Celic produced the report.

The first case of infectious disease were registered on April 14, 2000. The authorised Ministry did not undertake the precautions, so epidemic situation started. International experts will soon give the recommendations how to deal with these infectious diseases. Sevko Bajic produced the report.
