"information which shows that the detonators placed inside the explosive device in the terrorist attack were made in BiH." He stated that RS MoI is in possession of a

list "of 1,740 persons from various Middle Eastern countries who were in BiH during the war, of whom 200 are of Bosniak nationality, and who were members of Mujahidin units in BiH." According to him, the list is incomplete as it is suspected that many more persons were included in Mujahidin units, bearing in mind that by the end of the war in 1995 they numbered 4,400 members. "The question is how many people were recruited, completed their training and where are they presently located, and

when these 'sleepers', as we call them, will be activated. This is the white Al-Qa'idah which is more dangerous than the one from Arab countries, as its members colour-wise are the same as [white] Europeans," Andan said. He concluded that RS MoI has a special team working on prevention of terrorism: "We are the first doors to Europe and we expect everyone to support us in this, including International Community."
