EuroBlic cover pg splash 'Loyalty to BiH along with "Lijepa nasa" hymn' and pg RS1 'Promising loyalty to BiH along with "Lijapa nasa" hymn' by Marija Milic reports on the incident in Capljina and carries the inset 'Prlenda: Procedure before everything' in which "Oslobodjenje" Sarajevo daily's commentator Antonio Prlenda says playing of Croatian hymn was a consequence of a poor procedure on the occasion of oath taking. 'This case cannot be called an incident, but only an undefined procedure. An incident is something that occurs in violation of the laws, while recruits in Capljina have respected BiH Defense Law', Prlenda says. Nevertheless, he does not think playing of the Croatian hymn was a good thing since it only confuses the public.

Dnevni Avaz pg 5 'I will lobby for BiH in the European Union' by Sead Numanovic - In an interview to DA, Senior Deputy HR, Martin Ney, says he will use his diplomatic experience to lobby for BiH to get as closer as possible to EU. In this regard, he says it is very important to carry out the necessary reforms, especially those on police and public broadcasting system. Asked how current dead end in PBS reforms is to be overcome, Ney says he calls on HDZ to reconsider its position once more: "The rights of Croat people in the draft of this law are entirely respected, but not through the channel in Croat language but through participation in managing and workings of public broadcasting system. while he is to meet with SDA leader **Sulejman Tihic** this week. The topic of discussions is solving the "deep crisis of authorities", especially in the CoM. He concludes he is optimistic in this regard, and certain some solution will be found. Political parties on CoM crisis

"Working team and the Commission, which has been established to carry this out, is looking for the solutions on how to do that without increasing the price of fuel in this moment", said Dokic adding public discussion will be organized on corridor 5c.
