SD explains that Cengic agreed to the mildest possible indictment and in return, "the international factors" will give up on persecuting Cengic for much serious deeds Cengic and other senior SDA officials had been involved in. As long as time doesn't happen, citizens of this country will continue to enter European countries with visas," commented EC spokesperson, Frane Maroevic. On the other hand, spokeswoman of BiH Foreign Ministry, Lepa Babic, says that BiH has made several steps in that direction, including introduction of the CIPS project, revision of the citizenships awarded in the recent past, adoption of the set of security laws, establishment of the State Border services and the state

Commission for fight against crime. She added that BiH has also imposed visas for Iranian and Saudi Arabian citizens.
