Ambassador Ney underlined the Agency's role in further defense reform, which should be implemented by the end of the year, i.e. transfer of employees from FBiH Defense Ministry to the State Ministry, was announced by the Agency, which should follow audit process. Director of FBiH Civil Service Agency Enver Iseric, stated: "The FBiH Defense Ministry has not yet harmonized the rulebook on internal organization of civil service bodies with the Law on Civil Service in Federation BiH and the relevant bylaws, which is the basic precondition for revision. Apart from this, there will be a problem if the revision reveals that a certain number of employees should be fired. Than, the Agency would be obligated to announce a public concourse on behalf of this ministry for occupying those vacated posts." He added that if the FBiH Government gave consent to the rulebook on internal organization of the Ministry by the end of August, the Agency would immediately launch the revision.
