Oslobodjenje, front pg splash and pg 7 'Ratko Mladic is hiding on Topcider', by <u>Bran</u>islav Boskov, Dnevni Avaz, pg 4, mentioned on front 'Popovic: SCG Army guards Ratko Mladic at Topcider', by E. Sarac - Vladimir - Beba **Popovic**, former Head of Public Relations Office at the Government of late Prime Minister Zoran Djindjic, has stated for B92 that the Chief of security of Guard brigade in Topcider is Branislav Puhac, who has been a personal bodyguard of Ratko Mladic for the past ten years. 'Now, you conclude where Mladic might be', Popovic has said. He added: 'It is no secret that the Army is guarding Mladic. They have been quarding him even while we were at the Government. We have had information that the Army was guarding and controlling Mladic'. However, according to Avaz's information, it is not Puhac who is guarding Mladic, it is likely that the person in question is Lt-Col of the SCG Army, **Branislav Puhalo**, from Kalinovik, which is also Mladic's birthplace. Avaz also notes that the HR, Paddy Ashdown, placed his (Puhalo) name on the list of persons who are forbidden to enter the EU last year. **Nezavisne novine** pg 6 'The Army was guarding Ratko Mladic' by V.
