Former MBO leadership illegally enters BHDA premises

The BiH Democratic Alternative (BHDA) called an MBO extraordinary congress on Saturday in a last attempt to stop democratic process in the party. The BHDA reminded that the Sarajevo Canton Court confirmed a decision to change the party's name from MBO to BHDA. The BHDA Presidency also said that former MBO leaders, along with a group of supporters, illegally entered the party premises on Marsala Tito Street on Sunday. The BHDA will demand that security force and the [OSCE](#) protect the premises.
