## News Headlines

- Serb vandals demolish Bosniak houses and shops in Brcko suburb of Brodusa on Sunday after Yugoslav National Team defeats Norway 1-0 in EURO2000 Championships
- European Commission donates 10.6 million euros to project on reconstruction of refugee houses in BiH in 2000
- Srebrenica Municipality needs donations to boost refugee returns – Municipal officials assess
- First billion KM in civic privatization certificates has been spent in privatization process – BiH Federation Privatization Agency
- Cheated depositors of bankrupted Sarajevo-based SAB Banka intend to sue BiH Federation Government Banking Agency for their savings, which they want returned in full
- 1.2 million KM needed to test cattle in BiH Federation for Q-Fever disease
- Bodies of 58 illegal aliens attempting to enter Britain found in refrigerator truck in Dover

- BiH Liberals and Liberal Bosniak Organization (LB0) will formally proclaim establishment of new party Liberal Democratic Party (LDS) during Unification Congress this Saturday
- Funeral of RTV BiH employee Vasiljko Sudarevic held in Sarajevo on Monday
- Cornerstone laid for Memorial to Croats killed on 14 September 1993 in Uzdol, a village near Prozor town
- Entire region surrounding Sarajevo International Airport must be de-mined before airport can continue with normal operations
- Area around TV transmitter on Mount Velez, in Mostar, has been cleared of mines
- 450th generation of Gazi-Husref Bey's Islamic High School (medresa) will graduate this year
