## **TV BiH News Headlines:**

- BiH Elektroprivreda Steering Board accepts resignation of General Director Meho Obradovic, submitted at OHR's request
- Commenting on Obradovic's resignation, OHR spokesman Oleg Milisic says OHR only requested him to implement Mostar City Council's decision concerning payment of BiH Elektroprivreda contributions to Mostar Administration as defined by BiH Federation law (01:00)
- EBRD provides credit worth 50 million Euro to BiH as financial support for further development and reconstruction of BiH electricity system
- BiH Council of Ministers adopts draft budget for next year and discusses draft law on BiH state courts of law
- Yugoslavia becomes full <u>UN</u> member after eight years of isolation
- Chairman of BiH Presidency Zivko Radisic welcomes Yugoslavia's admission into <u>UN</u> (00:18)
- Two Israeli citizens killed, ten injured in Thursday car-bomb explosion at market place in western Jerusalem
- BiH Federation Government proposes amnesty for 78 prisoners in BiH Federation and drafts strategy of social security development in entity from 2001-2003
- Several hundred workers gather Thursday to protest poor economic status in rally organised by Zenica-Doboj Canton Independent Union in Zenica
- Tuzla-Orasje highway second lane cannot be built due to illegally constructed houses near highway – TV BiH feature story
- High Representative <u>Wolfgang Petritsch</u> tells session of Circle 99 Independent Intellectuals Association that he

doubts BiH citizens want to remain prisoners of nationalist leaders and adds that better future of BiH depends on citizens themselves (03:10)

- ICG proposes that <u>OSCE</u> ban SDS from participating in November General Elections due to its extreme nationalist policy
- Asked if <u>OSCE</u> will accept ICG's proposal, <u>OSCE</u> Head of Mission Robert Barry said there is no foundation for such move yet, adding he doubted SDS would provoke such an <u>OSCE</u> step in remaining days of campaign
- OSCE's Barry expresses hope BiH Croat referendum will not be held on Election Day and adds that, if it does takes place, the matter will be forwarded to EASC for consideration (00:30)
- Mirza Hajric, Foreign Policy Adviser for Bosniak member of BiH Presidency Halid Genjac, expresses dissatisfaction with TV BiH's unprofessional coverage of Genjac's activities, referring to recent visit to Srebrenica (00:44)
- TV BiH editorial staff denies Hajric's allegations, reminding him that media in BiH are banned by PEC Rules and Regulations to show activities of state officials in a way which might favour any political party
