Two BiH Federation Army soldiers were killed, one is missing while 17 are wounded in explosion occurred yesterday about 17:00 in military storage in the place Vrelo near Cazin, during carrying out daily duties. The Ministry of Defence published that investigation continues. 1:00

BiH Parliament Assembly House of People held a session in Lukavica and adopted the Law on BiH Customs Policy. The HoP did not adopt addendum on the Law on Passports and the Law on BiH Administration Taxes. The last HoP session in this mandate lasted for 15 minutes. 1:30

NATO Secretary General, Solana plans a visit to BiH two days before the elections, in order to encourage the voters body. The alliance also held their first meeting after the summer and the main issue was the matter of BiH upcoming elections. 1:00

US President Clinton and Russian President Yeltsin signed two agreements; Agreement on Arming and Agreements on Anti-Rocked Alert and decrease of Plutonium reserves. 2:00

Albanian sources from Kosovo reported that 15 Kosovo Liberation Army soldiers were killed in yesterday's conflicts in the region of Prizren, and that Serbian forces continued military operations today, progressing toward settlements in Prizren suburban area. Information centre reported that 15.000 people from Prizren spent last night under the open sky. 2:00 Two more Bosniak houses were destroyed in explosion in Stolac said UN spokeswoman, Moore at the press conference of international organisations held in Mostar. Moore said that this was 42nd incident in Stolac since March 24 this year, and none of these cases were solved. The main issue of the conference was refugee return to the Herzegovina/Neretva Canton. Commenting on HR Westendorp's decision to prolong the interim arrangement of the Mostar Airport administration for another six months, OHR regional head Sir Martin Garrod said that it was impossible to transfer management of the airport to the City of Mostar authorities, considering that this institution is not functioning at all. 1:30

92 percent of murder cases in BiH Federation were solved so far, said the Federation Internal Affairs Minister, Zilic, after the meeting Zilic, and his deputy Leutar held with HN Canton Minister, Coric and his deputy Dziho. Zilic said that the main issue of the meeting was continuance of police establishment, and freedom of movement during the elections from the aspect of police forces. 2:00

Collective funeral of 20 Bosniaks from Nevesinje killed in 1992 was carried out today in Mostar. Bosniak bodies were found in mass and individual graves in the area of this municipality.

BiH and BiH Federation Government sent new convoy of aid to 100 more houses of returnees to Brcko. Most of the aid was construction material. Brcko citizens expressed their gratitude to President Izetbegovic, as the initiator of this action and said that the State of BiH is their best friend after all.

TPK Canton Government will provide 1 million DEM aid for areas
