Bosniak children from Vitez still do not have the place for school. Only school in Vitez has Croat educational programme, and classes for Bosniak children have been held in cafés or other similar facilities. Bosniak authorities, as well as the parents of these children still cannot resolve this problem.

The meeting in Belgrade is a public secret in the RS. Allegedly, a compromise was made at this meeting that a radical will replace the RS President Plavsic, while the "Sloga" candidate Zivko Radisic will replace Krajisnik in the Presidency. Newspapers in Banja Luka are confirming these rumours, while voters are divided, one side is celebrating and the other one is concerned. Quoting the speculations from SP of the RS Belgrade's daily "Danas" reports on possibility of Coalition between RS Radicals, the SDS, Socialist Party of the RS and Plavsic's party SNS. Serbian Radicals leader Seselj and RS Radicals leader Poplasen said that Radicals are considering the possibility of coalition with the SNS, because, as they said, this would lead to replacement of Biljana Plavsic.

(BiH TV anchor) – From their cozy cabinets, Belgrade is playing with the fate of Kosovo. Hungarian Prime Minister announced that should Kosovo obtain autonomy, the same status will be demanded for Vojvodina as well. Albanian political subject, analysts' circles and even the citizens who the

recent proposal from US Ambassador, Hill, rejected it, qualifying it as non-serious approach to such burning problem in the Balkans.

– There followed the world news. Experts' team began exhumations of several mass graves in the region of Brisevo near Ljubija. It was reported that the aggressor has buried about 70 bodies of Croat citizens of this area. About 30 bodies were exhumed so far and 9 autopsies have been carried out. It was determined that the victims died mostly of gunfire injuries in the head.

Three years ago, in August 1995, the aggressor blew up the Church of Virgin Mary in Sanski Most. Today, the cornerstone was laid at the same place, with the presence of many followers from Una/Sana Canton and guests from Holland, who are donors of this object.
