News Headlines

- Fire raging in Konjic Municipality
- Social rebellion could occur at beginning of September due to very difficult material situation of working class – BiH Independent Trade Union President Sulejman Hrle
- Liberal Party and LBO hold Unification Congress and form new party called Liberal Democratic Party (LDS) BiH
- SDP BiH Main Board adopts election strategy it will use in upcoming BiH General Elections in November
- BiH Patriotic Party (BPS) Mostar Board holds formative session for Herzegovina region and appoints new members
- (GDS President) Ibrahim Spahic condemns all forms of attack on journalists, and requests authorities to draft legislation to protect freedom of speech and work of media

- Neum hotel Zenit, previously owned by Zenica Iron Mill, bought by Brodomerkur Company from Split
- Djukanovic publicly apologizes to Mesic for suffering and material damages inflicted by all Montenegrin members of Yugoslav National Army (JNA) during 1991 JNA attack on Croatia

- Serbian Orthodox Church in Cetinje is operating according to dictates of Belgrade regime, and is holding almost all Montenegrin Orthodox Church property under its control due to political reasons – Montenegrin Metropolitan Mihajlo
