Top news in the RTV BiH newscast was BiH basketball team winning over the Estonian team.

3:00

RTV BiH news reported on congratulations on the Day of Independence from and to the Presidency, and other BiH state authorities and political parties.

1:30

President of the SDA party, Alija Izetbegovic addressed his greetings to Zlatko Lagumdzija and Selim Beslagic due to their appointment to highest posts of the United Social Democrats Party of BiH.

1:00

Belgrade regime military and police forces are accumulating in Kosovo, while the Kosovo Liberation Army is preparing for defence. All sources confirmed murder of one Serbian policeman and four were wounded.

2:00

Computer hackers gained control over British military-communications satellite, demanding money, British "Sunday Business" reported. Several weeks ago, hackers changed the route of one out of four British Army satellites.

1:00

Spomenka Pelic is the third person injured by falling brick in Sarajevo. Spomenka Pelic was seriously injured, but conscious and is currently hospitalised at the Neuro-Clinical department of the Kosevo Hospital. The Sarajevo Canton Government held special session, and allocated two million KM for urgent repairs of all buildings in Sarajevo, but the City Institution

for Urbanism said this money would hardly cover the most urgent repairs.
