Adana — More than 100 people died and over 1500 were wounded in the earthquake which hit southern parts of the Republic of Turkey yesterday. At the epicentre, near Adana, its intensity was 6,3 on the Richter scale. The first earthquake was followed by 40 smaller after-shocks.

Cran Montana — Richard Holbrooke, US President Clinton's Special Envoy for Kosovo and US Ambassador to the UN confirmed today that Washington had the first official talks with leaders of the Liberation Army of Kosovo. Holbrooke warned that Europe was only a few steps away from general war and directly accused Milosevic for it. According to the majority of us the prime responsibility for war in Kosovo lies with Belgrade and its Government's actions in the last ten years, he said.
