

OHR BiH TV News Summary, 6 December 1998

Brcko Supervisor Farrand met with RS President Poplasen and BiH President Radisic in Banja Luka. Main issue of the meeting was the situation in Brcko, Farrand said. Poplasen's cabinet announced that one of the issues of the meeting was resolving the problem of housing regardless of nationality, in accordance with Farrand's special decisions, as well as multiethnic judiciary system, allocation of land for house construction, privatisation of enterprises and municipality authorities.

The US Government confirmed that programme is being prepared, which offers \$5 million reward for information on war criminals. Recently arrested Serb General, Krstic directly responsible for the crimes in Srebrenica, will have his first hearing before the [ICTY](#) tomorrow.

After the Serb occupation of Srebrenica and the three-year exile, a group of survived Srebrenica citizens visited Potocari. RTV BiH also brought interviews with Srebrenica citizens.

Exhumation in Sanski Most will begin tomorrow. The State experts' team will work on the "Hrastova Glava" mass grave that is supposed to be one of the biggest mass graves in this area. It is also supposed that the pit contains about 150 bodies of killed prisoners from the "Omarska" camp.

40 French soldiers, members of the [NATO](#) forces arrived to Skopje. The task of the soldiers will be to assist withdrawal

of the OSCE verification mission from Kosovo, in the case of danger. They are also supposed to prepare the ground for arrival of other [NATO](#) soldiers to Macedonia.
