- Ljubisa Savic 'Mauzer', a former senior RS Interior Ministry official, a founder of the SDS, the commander of the RS Army special paramilitary unit Panthers, shot to death in Bijeljina, perpetrators unknown
- Zivko Radisic condemns Mauzer assassination
- SNS loyal to Plavsic says that assassination of Mauzer is terrorist act
- SDS expresses bitterness and shock over Mauzer assassination
- Dodik comments on Mauzer assassination, expresses sorrow over the act and condemns it, saying a good man was killed
- Regular international press conference in Sarajevo, OHR expects BiH Presidency to systematically and transparently approach procedure of electing members to Council of Ministers; and, informs that the draft law on freedom of information is almost completed
- Jelavic considers that Izetbegovic's resignation should be viewed in light of his health and age
