### 3. Review of Cluster Areas for 1998

#### 3.1. Return in 1997 to Cluster Areas

The April 1997 RRTF Report foresaw a return potential of approximately 100,000 displaced persons and refugees to the designated cluster areas. The prediction turned out realistic, as illustrated below. The only cluster area to fall significantly below expectation was the Anvil. The 1998 Cluster areas have been revised accordingly, to exclude the Anvil (see sections <u>4.2.</u> and <u>4.3.</u>).
