- Serb Orthodox Church celebrates 100 years of Banja Luka Eparchy, proclaims Banja Luka Bishop Platon, killed by Ustasha in 1941, to be martyr
- Celebration of ninth anniversary of RS Army 16th Brigade held in Masici village near Gradiska
- BiH delegation to participate in [UNHCR](#) Annual Conference in Geneva
- BiH still has not received any money from Stability Pact program; Stability Pact envisions DM 525 million for BiH – Minister for European Integration Bisera Turkovic
- DOS holds election rally in Pozarevac
- 83% citizens will participate in Yugoslav election, 45% will vote for Kostunica, 38% for Milosevic, and 10% for SRS's Tomislav Nikolic – Strategic Marketing Agency using sample of 2,000 citizens of Serbia, without Kosovo
- Movement for Democratic Serbia President Momcilo Perisic says if opposition cannot implement election results democratically, it may take over its share of power using force
