RT RS News Headlines:

- OSCE announces first preliminary election results for 68 of 164 RS and BiH Federation municipalities; SDS presidential candidates won 47.9% of vote, SNSD 31.3%, PDP 9%; in race for RS National Assembly, SDS wins 36.8%, SNSD 17.9%, PDP 15.4%; in race for BiH House of Representatives, SDS wins 41.3%, PDP 19.2% and SNSD-DSP 13%
- OHR will co-operate with newly-elected authority but it must not obstruct implementation of <u>Dayton Agreement</u> – OHR spokesperson Chris Bird
- SDS satisfied with party's election results SDS presidential candidate Mirko Sarovic
- PDP RS Vice President Zoran Djeric states that PDP is satisfied with party's election results
- <u>OSCE</u> first preliminary election results will eliminate confusion in preliminary results of political parties – SNSD General Secretary Slavko Mitrovic
- SPRS Election HQ Deputy Head Dusko Bajic says SPRS has checked 500,000 votes so far, which is more than <u>OSCE</u> checked even if it has larger number of activists
- Both people and IC wanted change and they got it SDS Presidency Chairman Dragan Kalinic; Sarovic expects victory in first round of RS presidential elections
- PDP RS won 20% of vote for BiH House of Representatives and 17% (like SNSD) for RS National Assembly – PDP RS President Mladen Ivanic
- SPRS Election HQ holds press conference in Banja Luka and states it is satisfied with party's results
- SDA expects it will have eight delegates in new RS National Assembly – SDA official Sulejman Tihic

- SDP BiH will have minimum of five delegates in RS National Assembly – SDP BiH Vice President Sejfudin Tokic
