Sarovic statement on RS presidential crisis

RS Vice-president Mirko Sarovic stated that he did not shun his responsibility by not taking over the function of RS President and that he respects the demands of the IC. "The problem of the RS President is in the hands of the High Representative, who has frozen the issue of the presidential function" added Sarovic. The letter former High Representative Carlos Westendorp at the time of the <u>NATO</u> aggression blocks Sarovic, because Westendorp requested he remain RS Vice-president and Dodik RS Prime Minister. Following this letter, Sarovic added that nobody from the IC contacted him, but that he was ready to discuss all issues openly. "The function of the RS President is not my private issue, it is a thing for complete agreement in the RS" considers Sarovic. "In the interest of the RS, a permanent strengthening of relations with Serbia, Montenegro and other countries is needed. It is for the welfare of our (Serb) nation from both sides of the Drina River that the connection and cooperation not be misused."
