

OHR RTRS News Summary, 19 August 2000

News Headlines:

- Yugoslavia adopts Regulation on Vehicle Insurance Fee for vehicles entering country from RS, DM 150 for passenger vehicles, DM 350 for trucks and DM 300 for buses
- Montenegro will not implement Yugoslav Government Regulation on Vehicle Insurance Fee – Montenegrin Ministry for Transport and Maritime Affairs
- Decision of BiH Border Service on insurance fee for vehicles coming from Yugoslavia, KM 25 for three days, and KM 40 for five days, is illegal because insurance in competency of BiH entities – RS Finance Minister Novak Kondic
- BiH Council of Ministers not acquainted with decision of BiH Border Service (insurance fee for Yugoslav vehicles entering RS) – Tihomir Gligoric
- RS de-mining team begins clearance operation by retrieving bodies from minefield in village Mesici, near Rogatica
- RS Commission for Missing Persons discovers six bodies during exhumation works in Gorazde
- Izetbegovic confirms withdrawal from duties as member of BiH Presidency on 12 October – Dnevni Avaz
- Serb Patriarch Pavle participates in liturgy in Moscow church Christ the Savior
- Holy Transfiguration celebration is held in all Orthodox churches throughout RS and BiH Federation
