SNS representative in the RS Assembly and member of the SNS Main Board Milica Markovic Elez held a press conference in Bijeljina. Elez stated that Sloga would not give up on the initiative for extraordinary presidential elections if RS Vice-president Mirko Sarovic does not assume presidential duties. Elez welcomes Sarovic's initiative on assuming presidential duties because it will solve the presidential crisis. By assuming presidential duty, Sarovic will unblock many RS institutions, which would help stabilize the RS.
