News Headlines:

- RS Government supports signing of Memorandum of Understanding between RS Government and BiH Federation on assistance to Brcko District regarding return of refugees, economy and mine clearance
- RS National Assembly (RS NA) adopts Law on RS Pension and Disability Insurance (PIO), draft Law on Labor, and draft Law on Labor Inspection
- 13th session of RS NA was very productive Djokic
- RS NA showed that it presents factor of stabilization in RS – NA Vice-President Jovan Mitrovic
- Adoption of laws by RS NA is important step in establishing legal framework in RS – RS Vice-President Ostoja Kremenovic
- RS NA adopts several laws in 13th session despite different political positions – SNSD member Krstan Simic
- Adopted Law on PIO will face obstacles during implementation – DSP Vice-President Momir Malic
- DNS is pleased with work of 13th session of RS NA DNS spokesperson Ostoja Barasin

- Prince Aleksandar Karadjordjevic calls on Yugoslav citizens to participate in Sunday's elections and to vote for DOS
- If Milosevic stages elections, IC must be ready to cancel his legality – Clinton
- Romanian Defense Ministry denies statement of Yugoslav Government that international military exercise held in Romania is related to elections in Yugoslavia
- HVO General Ivan Andabak is main suspect in murder of BiH Federation Deputy Interior Minister Jozo Leutar – Jacques Klein
- Croatian Interior Ministry spokesperson rejects Klein's statement, saying that Andabak is suspected of drug trafficking
- Petritsch supports preliminary results of investigation into Leutar's murder

- Recent arrest actions in BiH Federation would have taken less time if there had not been obstruction from Croat side in BiH Federation Interior Ministry – <u>UN</u> spokesperson Stefo Lehmann
- <u>UN</u> Mission is concerned that 90 Serb houses in Bocinja were robbed after mujahedins were evicted from them – <u>UN</u> spokesperson Alun Roberts
- Hand grenade explodes in northern Kosovska Mitrovica, no casualties reported – KFOR
- Unknown person throws hand grenade at Kosovo Serb house in Kosovo Polje, no casualties reported
- UNMIK is interrogating six Serbs arrested recently in Gracanica to see if they are members of Yugoslav Army special forces – UK KFOR
