- Fires raging in RS (Ozren, Trebinje, Doboj, Nevesinje)

- IC will fill budget coffers in BiH one last time – US Special Envoy Richard Sclar, mentioning that corruption and smuggling are linked to budgetary deficits in both BiH entities
- Yugoslav custom officials did not allow RS Tourism and Trade Minister Nikola Kragulj to cross border into Yugoslavia on private visit
- 34 bodies of Serb civilian victims of war exhumed in Sarajevo, Konjic and Gorazde, and 27 successfully identified in Sarajevo
