- Yugoslav Interior Minister Zoran Zivkovic rejects any possible [territorial] advance of Albanian terrorists
- Yugoslav Army and leadership working in peaceful manner and through diplomatic channels to achieve Albanian withdrawal from buffer zone — Yugoslav Army Chief of HQ Staff Nebojsa Pavkovic
- Serbian Deputy Premier Nebojsa Covic denies information concerning mass exodus of Albanian population from Bujanovac, as well as unreadiness of police to respond to this problem
- Majority of 3,000 Albanians who abandoned southern Serbia for Kosovo left before extension of cease-fire deadline — <u>UN</u> spokesperson Chris Janowski
- US accuses armed Albanian troops of undermining process of establishing democracy and stability in Kosovo and region
- <u>EU</u> assesses acts committed by Albanian terrorists last week in Pristina and buffer zone to be criminal
- Last week's incidents in Kosovo show that security of non-Albanian population in Kosovo is in extremely dissatisfactory state — Russian ambassador to <u>UN</u> Sergey Lavrov
- DOS member and head of G17PLUS Mladjan Dinkic appointed new governor of Yugoslav National Bank
- Joint session of Yugoslav Parliamentary Assembly Council of Republics and Council of Citizens adjourns after delegates fail to reach agreement on appointment of deputy governor for Yugoslav National Bank
- Montenegrin assesses Yugoslav Parliamentary Assembly that has appointed governor of Yugoslav National Bank as illegitimate — Milo Djukanovic answering Kostunica
