HDZ BiH Central Bosnia Board to organize protest rally

As reported by Croatian radio, Croats from Central Bosnia are dissatisfied with the <u>ICTY</u> sentence against Croatian General Tihomir Blaskic and have announced protest rallies. The main rally will be held in Kiseljak on 8 March, as decided by the HDZ BiH Central Bosnia Cantonal Board. The Board requested an immediate meeting between the Croat political leadership in BiH in order to reexamine relations with the <u>ICTY</u>.

SDA Main Board warns **OSCE** to be neutral during elections
