Klein associated Karadzic's case with the disability of the west to confront the evil. In his opinion, stabilization forces are ready to arrest Karadzic, but political will is lacking at higher levels.

Prijedor Mayor and Sanski Most acting Mayor sign agreement on return of double occupancy property and flats

In Sanski Most, Prijedor Mayor Borislav Maric and acting Mayor of Sanski Most Muhamed Lames signed an agreement on the return of double occupancy property and flats in both cities by 15 February. By 15 March, flats and property used by preferential categories should be returned. By 1 April, property and flats used illegally by refugees and displaced persons are expected to be returned. The return of places of business is also defined in the agreement.
